This position will be in charge of all the sound and video needs for the season spanning across two stages. This is a full-time, year-around position paying \$40,000/yr plus a benefits package, matching 401k and housing.

Responsibilities:

- Maintain all audio and video equipment
- Provide all audio/video support for Theatre's production season, including, but not limited to:
 - headset systems
 - dressing room, Green room and lobby audio/video systems
 - conductor and stage management audio/video monitors
 - assisted listening systems
 - Open caption system
- Attend all technical rehearsals and previews as necessary
- Mix performances as required
- Hire, train and schedule any needed departmental employees
- Provide audio/video support for special events
- Create and maintain sound department budget
- Assist guest sound designers
- Attend bi-weekly production meetings
- Record any needed voiceovers, special effects, announcements, etc.
- Facilitate sound for the Barter Players
- Other duties as assigned

Ideal candidate will also fulfill the role of Sound Designer for some shows as needed each season.

- BA/BFA or MFA in technical theatre with an emphasis on sound and at least 2 years experience in a professional performing arts environment OR a minimum of 4 years acting as an Audio/Video supervisor in a professional performing arts setting.
- Strong knowledge of Qlab, NDI, Dante, Allen and Heath dLive Console, X32/M32 Console, live mixing of up to 40+ channels, instrument mic'ing techniques, basic video knowledge for setting up and maintaining the IR and cam systems as well as projectors.
- Ability to troubleshoot and problem solve
- Ability to remain calm in high stress situations
- Be a team player at all times
